Homework

Homework/Classwork will be given daily. Homework will be reviewed each block and then assessed through homework quizzes. Students may use **their** homework on these quizzes. All work must be shown on all quizzes in order to receive credit. Homework quizzes do not need to be made up when missed because of an absence

Late Work

Timely completion of all assignments is required. Late work will be accepted by the end of the unit with penalty not to exceed 50%.

Explanation of Zeroes

- A 0 in the gradebook indicates that the assignment has been graded, but was either not turned in or earned zero credit.
- A X in the gradebook, the student is exempt from that assignment.
- A Z in the gradebook means the assignment was not turned in and currently not calculated in the total average; however, if the assignment is not turned in, a zero will be given.
- Empty spaces in the gradebook indicate that the assignment has not been graded, but soon will be.

Any student with a “D” or “E” average will have their parent/guardian contacted by the teacher.

Reassessment

- Allowed 1 reassessment per quarter as long as student has done 100% of their homework and has completed an established remediation process (i.e. IXL and tutoring)
- New grade will be recorded and old grade discarded.

Make-up Work

- Timely completion of all assignments is required.
- It is the responsibility of the student to find out what homework, notes, test, or quizzes were missed and to make up accepted work within 1 week after the absence.
- If you miss a test review, you are still responsible to take the test on the regular scheduled date. Notes, test review and solutions are posted in Google Classroom.
