### Homework

Homework will not count in the grading.

### Late Work

Assignments that were not turned in on the day they were due will be accepted with penalty no more than one week from the date it was due.

### Explanation of Zeroes

A 0 in the gradebook indicates that the assignment has been graded, but was either not turned in or earned zero credit. A X in the gradebook, the student is exempt from that assignment. A Z in the gradebook means the assignment was not turned in and currently not calculated in the total average; however, if the assignment is not turned in, a zero will be given.

### Reassessment

The student will have two weeks to complete a reassessment. Tutoring is required for retakes (IXL reviews, teacher tutor, test corrections, etc.) The final grade will be calculated as follows: 80% retake grade, 20% original grade.

### Make-up Work

Timely completion of all assignments is required. A student that was absent on the day homework, class work, test, or quiz was given will have one week from the day they return to school to complete the missed work. If a student does not make up their work within one week from an absence, it will then be considered late work and the late work policy will be used. Academic detentions will be used as necessary to insure assignment completion.
