Homework

Homework will consist of work that cannot be completed during class time. This work will be expected to be turned in during the next class period.

Late Work

Explanation of Zeroes

A 0 in the gradebook that indicates that the assignment has been graded, but was either not turned in or earned zero credit. A X in the gradebook, the student is exempt from that assignment. A Z in the gradebook means the assignment was not turned in and currently not calculated in the total average; however, if the assignment is not turned in, a zero will be given. Empty spaces in the gradebook indicate that the assignment has not been graded, but soon will be. Any student with a “D” or “E” average will have their parent/guardian contacted by the teacher.

Reassessment

Reassessments are permitted at the teacher's discretion. This will be determined on a case by case basis.

Make-up Work

Timely completion of all assignments is required.

Make Up Work and Late Work:

* Pre-assigned work (such as projects/essays) must be turned in on time. If you are absent, I expect you to email the assignment as an attachment or have someone bring it to school for you.

* If you are absent on the day of a test or quiz, it is your responsibility to request a make-up time.
