Homework

Homework will consist of work that cannot be completed during class time. This work will be expected to be turned in during the next class period

Late Work

Late work will be accepted when complete by the student.

Explanation of Zeroes

A 0 in the gradebook that indicates that the assignment has been graded, but was either not turned in or earned zero credit. A X in the gradebook, the student is exempt from that assignment. A Z in the gradebook means the assignment was not turned in and currently not calculated in the total average; however, if the assignment is not turned in, a zero will be given. Empty spaces in the gradebook indicate that the assignment has not been graded, but soon will be. Any student with a “D” or “E” average will have their parent/guardian contacted by the teacher.

Reassessment

Retest will be given for students who received a failing grade and have attended an after school tutoring lesson.

Make-up Work

Timely completion of all assignments is required. When absence for an assessment, make up dates will be determined by the teacher after school or during a study period. Academic detentions will be used as necessary to insure assignment completion.

Extra credit may be assigned during the semester
