



## **Grading Practices**

School: Tallwood High School

Subject(s): Mixed Chorus

Grade Level: 9-12

### **Homework**

Homework assignments will not exceed 10% of a student's cumulative grade.

### **Late Work**

There is no way to replicate a concert performance. Students who miss a performance will supply proper documentation and will be given an alternative assignment and can earn up to 80%. Students who miss a performance without official documentation will be given an alternative assignment and can earn up to 64%. Students will be given a reasonable deadline that addresses the student's individual circumstances.

### **Explanation of Zeroes**

A "0" will be given to a student for a formative or summative assignment where NO work has been submitted or no work has been completed.

### **Reassessment**

There may be reassessment opportunities for students who receive a failing grade on a summative assessment (unit tests, research papers) with the exception of a performance when certain provisions are met such as class participation, completed class assignments, and evidence of their very best efforts. Students will have a deadline of one week to complete the reassessment.

### **Make-up Work**
