Online problems are listed each day in the assignment log and due before the next class. At the end of each unit, students will receive an online assignment/quiz grade based on their work in MathXL. Please communicate with me immediately if you do not have online access at home or if you are having technical issues. Passes can be written to use the computers in the library during study block, lunch, or after school.

Online Assignments/Quizzes are assigned to further learning by providing specific examples for students to practice individually.

Late Work

- Timely completion of all assignments is required. Late work will be accepted by the end of the unit with penalty not to exceed 50%.

Explanation of Zeroes

- “o” - The assignment has been graded, but was either not turned in or earned zero credit.

Reassessment

- Allowed 1 reassessment per quarter as long as student has scored at least 80% on all of their online assignments/quizzes and has completed an established remediation process (i.e. tutoring).
- New grade will be recorded and old grade discarded.

Make-up Work

- Timely completion of all assignments is required.
- It is the responsibility of the student to find out what homework, notes, test, or quizzes were missed and to make up accepted work within 2 classes after the absence.
- If you miss a test/exam review, you are still responsible to take the test/exam on the regularly scheduled date. Notes, Test/Exam Reviews and solutions are posted in Google Classroom.

Extra credit projects may be assigned at the discretion of the teacher. A maximum of 15 points earned will be added to the lowest test grade.
